GUIDELINES FOR NOMINATING & SELECTING HONOR COUPLE/PERSON

Each Federation or Council in the State of Ohio selects an Honor Couple or Person yearly. The Ohio Corporation of Dance Clubs traditionally recognizes the Honorees and presents them at the opening ceremonies of the Ohio's State Dance Convention (Saturday night).

An Honor Couple/Person will have contributed to the Square Dance activity on many levels and will be individuals we would be proud to have represent COCDC.

QUALIFICATIONS:

Listed below are a few points to help remind you of possible activities and contributions of your nominee. Please note that accomplishments should pertain to club and dance related activities. The nominee's participation at the state and national/international levels will be taken into consideration for selection. The qualifications below coincide with the scoring sheet when judging the criteria forms.

- Number of years in square dance activity.
- Club memberships.
- Club leadership positions – offices and committees.
- New dancer support – angeling, demonstrations, publicity, mentoring, etc.
- Participation in Banner Raid Program.
- Participation in Council, State and National/International organizations – including membership, committees, offices held, etc.
- Council and/or State badges/dangles earned.
- State and National/International Conventions attended.
- Special Events attended – fund raisers, charity dances, etc.
- Chairperson and/or committee service for conventions & special events.
- Individual accomplishments contributing to the dance activity.
- Any other activity that demonstrates commitment to the dance community.
- Emphasis should be on activities within the past 15 year time frame.
